#### **GI Procedures**

Procedures performed in the 2006-2007 fiscal year in the GI lab included 1408 colonoscopies, 959 EGDs, 59 flexible sigmoidoscopies, 612 EUS, and 3399 ERCPs. A total of 2591 patients were seen. Wait times for an appointment for a clinic visit is three to seven months and two to six months for a procedure.

#### Clinical Gastroenterology Fellowship Program

This is a three-year program with two first-year positions available. The program is based at UMC, Southern Arizona VA Medical Center and UPH-Kino Campus. Training follows RRC guidelines for program/conferences. The third year of the fellowship allows trainees to focus on a particular area. The UMC endoscopy lab has the capacity to perform pancreaticobiliary endoscopy and endoscopic ultrasound. Esophageal and anorectal motility are also performed.
