Mayor Jonathan Rothschild

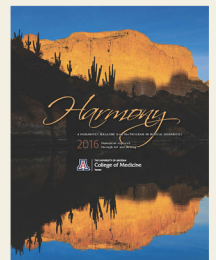
Wednesday, February 14th, 2018 at noon in Duval Auditorium
