


## Magdalene So, PhD

## "DNA uptake: the Achilles Heel of *Neisseria* gonorrhoeae"

Dr. Magdalene So is a Professor in the UA Department of Immunobiology and a member of the UA BIO5 Institute. Her research focuses on *Neisseria gonorrhoeae* (below) and *Neisseria meningitidis*. Using genetics, genomics, biochemistry and high-resolution imaging, she seeks to understand the mechanisms by which these pathogens establish asymptomatic infection. Her interest now includes commensal *Neisseria*, and she seeks to understand how commensal and pathogenic *Neisseria* interact on mucosal surfaces.
