Matched Applicant Type. All values are in percentages of total matched applicants. (5) U.S. MD seniors are students enrolled in a medical school accredited by the LCME with a graduation date after July 1 in the year before the Match; (6) U.S. MD graduates have a graduation date before July 1 in the year before the Match; (7) U.S. DO seniors/graduates are students in or graduates of medical schools accredited by the AOA Commission on Osteopathic College Accreditation (COCA); (8) U.S. DO seniors are students enrolled in a medical school accredited by the COCA with a graduation date after July 1 in the year before the Match; (9) U.S. DO graduates have a graduation date before July 1 in the year before the Match; (10) U.S. IMGs are U.S. citizen students/graduates of international medical schools; (11) Non-U.S. IMGs are non-U.S. citizen students/graduates of international medical schools; and (12) Others includes students/graduates of Canadian medical schools, previous graduates of DO medical schools, and students/graduates of Fifth Pathway programs. Matched Applicant Characteristics. All values except AOA membership are means for matched applicants. (13) Volunteer experiences, (14) Work experiences, (15) Number of publications, (16) Research experiences, and (17) Alpha Omega Alpha (AOA) membership were self-reported by applicants. (18) USMLE Step 1 and (19) USMLE Step 2 scores also were self-reported. Source: NRMP Data Warehouse
Note. U.S. MD- and DO-granting medical schools were asked to verify the USMLE and/or COMLEX scores for their applicants. Only scores confirmed, corrected, or provided by medical schools were used in the calculations.

2020 USMLE Highlights. In 2020, 98 percent of U.S. MD seniors in the Match reported USMLE Step 1 scores, 91 percent of which were confirmed, corrected, or provided by U.S. MD-granting medical schools. Ninety-seven percent of U.S. MD seniors also reported USMLE Step 2 scores, 91 percent of which were confirmed, corrected, or provided by U.S. MD-granting medical schools. Among U.S. DO seniors in the Match in 2020, 59 percent reported USMLE Step 1 scores, 89 percent of which were confirmed, corrected, or provided by U.S. DO-granting medical schools. Fifty-one percent of U.S. DO seniors also reported USMLE Step 2 scores, 89 percent of which were confirmed, corrected, or provided by U.S. DO-granting medical schools.

(20) COMLEX-USA Level 1 and (21) COMLEX-USA Level 2 scores were self-reported by U.S. DO seniors in the Match and confirmed, corrected, or provided by U.S. DO-granting medical schools. In 2020, 98 percent of U.S. DO seniors reported COMLEX-USA Level 1 scores, 91 percent of which were confirmed, corrected, or provided by U.S. DO-granting medical schools. Ninety-eight percent of U.S. DO seniors also reported COMLEX-USA Level 2 scores, 91 percent of which were confirmed, corrected, or provided by U.S. DO-granting medical schools. Informed Consent and Institutional Review Board (IRB) Oversight. Data for calculating characteristics 13 through 21 were collected during applicants' Match registration process. Individual data were used only when consent was given for use in research. In 2020, consent was given by 91 percent of all applicants. IRB exemption for the data collection process was obtained from Chesapeake IRB.
