About the Presenter: Dr. Shroff is an associate professor of medicine and interim chief in the Division of Hematology and Oncology in the Department of Medicine at the University of Arizona College of Medicine – Tucson, where she is also associate dean for Clinical and Translational Research. She is the section chief of GI Medical Oncology, leader of the GI Clinical Research Team, and director of the Clinical Trials Office and Arizona Clinical Trials Network (ACTN) at the UArizona Cancer Center. She came to UArizona from Houston's MD Anderson Cancer Center, where she was on faculty from 2010-18 after completing her Medical Oncology Fellowship there. Dr. Shroff is a clinical and translational investigator focused on developing novel therapies for pancreatic and hepatobiliary cancers. As a result, she holds many posts nationally, including as Hepatobiliary Subcommittee co-chair, Southwest Oncology Group (SWOG), and Leadership Committee member, GI ASCO, which hosts the American Society of Clinical Oncology's Gastrointestinal Cancers Symposium. She also is a member of the ASCO Nominating Committee and the Scientific and Medical Advisory Board for the Cholangiocarcinoma Foundation.
