Yi-Zarn Wang, M.D., D.D.S., F.A.C.S., is a Professor of Surgery at Louisiana State University Health Sciences College School of Medicine. He is a member of the multidisciplinary team at the Ochsner Neuroendocrine Tumor Program in Kenner, Louisiana. His clinical interests include hepatobiliary, pancreatic surgery, radiofrequency and Nanoknife ablation of solid tumors. Dr. Wang received his dental training in Taiwan. He entered the graduate program in oral/general pathology at OHSU in Portland, Oregon where he obtained his medical degree.
